

Department of Astronomical Observations. The work of the year in this department may be summarized as follows: Prof. William Harkness, who retired from active service on December 15, 1899, was succeeded in the astronomical directorship by Prof. Stimson J. Brown, the senior professor of mathematics on duty at the Observatory. Professor Browns first duty was as member of a board of examiners, to fill the vacancy caused by the retirement of Professor Harkness by the selection of a suitable candidate for appointment as professor of mathematics in the Navy. The labors of this board, of which Prof. William Hendrickson, U. S. N., was senior member, resulted in the selection and appointment of Prof. W. S. Eichelberger.
