As the back and end boards on the right-hand side of the table are grooved to the rear right leg (Fig. 971), this leg must have a groove cut in the front and inner sides 1 ft. 3 in. long, reaching from the mortice of the top rail to that of the bottom rail. The sizes of the grooves and mortices are the same as those of the legs on the left. Fig. 972 shows the front right leg, which is prepared in the same way, with the difference that one of the grooves is replaced by mortices for the three rails running beneath the drawers.
