England carries her parcels post service upon slow goods trains in uncovered vans, simply protected by tarpaulins. The whole work is done in that way, and England still loses money upon the service, where the average haul is 42 miles, even at 6 cents for the first pound and 2 cents a pound after that. The number of periodicals represented by the American Publishers Association have so vastly increased the second-class mail service of the country that it has grown from the maximum number of pounds (40, 000, 000) in 1875, when the law was passed, to 108, 000, 000 for the past year. But the growth that has taken place in second-class matter in the last ten years is but a tittle of what will take place if this proposed parcels post legislation shall pass. There are eleven different bills before Congress at this session....
