

By subsequent legislative acts it is made the business of this station to analyze all the brands Of commercial fertilizers sold in the state, as well as to examine commercial cattle feeds and articles used for human food or drink on sale in Connecticut, with reference to their adulterations. Provision is also made for the testing and marking by this station of all apparatus used in determining the price of milk and cream. Through the state entomologist, a member of the station staff, the station is required to make regular inspections of nurseries, to visit and examine orchards, nurseries, fields, gar dens, or storehouses, at the request of their owners, to advise regarding treatment for insect pests and to diffuse information on the subject.
