

Most sellers recommend starting before age 65 while we are still healthy and insurable but we will pay more. Like all disability insurance, we are paying for something that we may not need at all. Unlike the cost of a major medical operation covered by our comprehensive health care plan, the cost of long-term care can be estimated fairly accurately. With a 13 and 4 chance of spending 2+ years in a nursing home for women and men respectively, the average cost will be about \$200,000. If we can stay at home, a home health aide costs about \$20,000 a year. The average policy costing \$2,500 a year will NOT cover all expenses.
