Excerpt from Study and Investigation of Boll Weevil and Hog Cholera Plagues While the work incident to carrying out the intent of the act was distributed among several of the divisions of the bureau, the branches now known as Farmer s Cooperative Demonstration Work and Acclimatization and Adaptation of Crop Plants and Cotton Breeding were specially charged with carrying on the work. In the case of the former branch the primary objects of its work were to prove that cotton could be grown with profit notwithstanding the presence of the boll weevil and to persuade the growers to adopt the cultural methods and means of control necessary to that end, and in the case of the latter to produce better types of early maturing varieties of cotton, adapted to the soil and climatic conditions of the boll weevil infested territory, the planting of early maturing varieties being a factor of great importance in reducing the ravages of the weevil.
