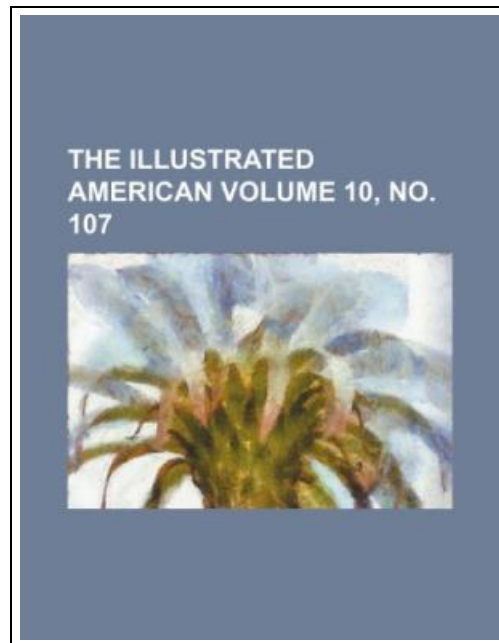

He had at once set engineers to begin the work. The stupendous task had been so silently completed that the secret had been kept from the enemy, despite all the cleverness of French spies. And even the British papers, which had frequently made incautious revelations of the position and probable movements of the allied armies; the British papers, against which Wellington had frequently and freely protested as the most dangerous adjuncts of the enemy--even they had not penetrated the secret.
