The new prices which applied to the entire output of the two districts, regardless of the thickness of the seams from which derived, were (inclusive of the 45-ccnt price increase because of the November, 1917, wage increase) as follows: run of mine, \$2.70; prepared sizes, \$2.95; slack \$2.45.
