

B-278745 INS In a December 1997 letter responding to our recommendations, told your Subcommittee that it recognized the need to automate its processes for identifying and tracking its processing and removal of criminal aliens. INS has begun an effort to establish an automated federal IHP tracking system that is to capture information, such as name, date of birth, country of birth, and A-number, if available, on foreign-born inmates in BOP correctional facilities. This information is to be used to perform record checks in other databases to make a determination on an aliens removability. As currently designed, the tracking system does not include information on removal hearings, nor does it capture data on whether INS aliens have been removed. According to, it plans to augment the tracking system by making it compatible with another system that is to include this information. We did not assess the feasibility of making the systems compatible. Also, officials told us...
