



Dimensions: 9.7in. x 7.4in. x 0.1in.In July 1982, it was disclosed that the Navy had developed a rating system to evaluate members of Congress. Pursuant to a congressional request, GAO conducted a review to: (1) document the extent of the use of rating files within the Department of Defense (DOD); (2) specifically identify those individuals involved in the creation, maintenance, and use of such files; and (3) determine the specific purpose of these rating files. GAO found that the numerical rating by DOD of congressional voting performance was limited to that developed by the Navys Office of Legislative Affairs. There was no evidence that the ratings were done at the direction of higher authorities either within DOD or the Navy. The Office of Legislative Affairs stated that a first rating was based on specific roll-call votes in the House and Senate. It selected the roll-call votes for this rating on the basis of whether the issue under consideration was of interest to the Navy or whether it was a major issue in terms of dollars to be expended or in terms of the potential effect it...
