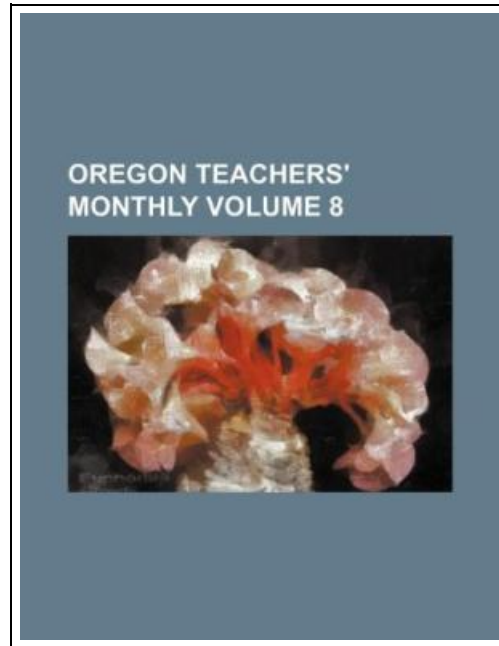

And the fund that is secured under its operation comes in a large measure from that class of teachers least able to pay. Tho teacher who holds a life diploma contributing but one dollar for all the institutes hold in his county during the time of his registration in that county, while the teachers holding county certificates must pay every one, two, or three years, as the case may be. Thn3 the funds are generally so limited that the superintendent is unable to secure suitable instructors; or should he sueceeu in this respect, the time is so limited that very small benefii is obtained. --F.
