It presupposes an elementary knowledge of psychology. In the earlier chapters, on the growth of structure, and of sensory and motor capacities, a certain amount of child psychology has been included. Not every item so included will be found applicable to teaching, but the aim has been to give to the student a general survey of the phenomena of growth. In later chapters, as on memory and reasoning, the procedure of certain class experiments has been reported in some detail, because they are not published elsewhere, and it may seem desirable to the instructor to duplicate them in laboratory exercises. The last three chapters take up some of the concrete questions of teaching in three quite dissimilar school subjects.
