I argue that the deviance from the linguistic norm finds a peak in the devoid of meaning in sound poetry, yet that by using verses without words, a deeper meaning of the poem is created. To support my thesis, I will firstly present the problem of an automatized language to explain the need for a new way of writing and perceiving literature, poems and art. In a second step, I will explain which linguistic devices were used by Russian formalists and exercise them on the poem Karawane by Hugo Ball.
