Brand New Book \*\*\*\*\* Print on Demand \*\*\*\*\*.GAO reviewed the Department of Defense's (DOD) fiscal year (FY) 1994 budget request and prior years appropriations for its research, development, test, and evaluation (RDTE) programs, focusing on: (1) potential reductions to the FY 1994 budget request; (2) rescissions to prior FY appropriations; and (3) congressional restrictions on DOD obligational authority for certain FY 1994 RDTE programs. GAO found that: (1) schedule delays, program requirement changes, and uncertainties have affected RDTE funding requests for 1994 and prior year appropriations; (2) potential budget reductions totalled \$472.6 million, prior year rescissions totalled \$42.7 million, and congressional restrictions on DOD obligational authority totalled \$958.3 million; (3) potential reductions in the Army's RDTE request totalled \$14.1 million, rescissions in the Army's 1992 and 1993 funding request totalled \$16.8 million, and restrictions on the Army's 1994 obligational authority totalled \$21.9 million; (4) potential reductions in the Navy's 1994 RDTE request total \$8.4 million, and rescissions in the Navy's FY 1992 and 1993 funding request totalled \$18.5 million; (5) potential reductions in the Air Force's 1994 RDTE...
