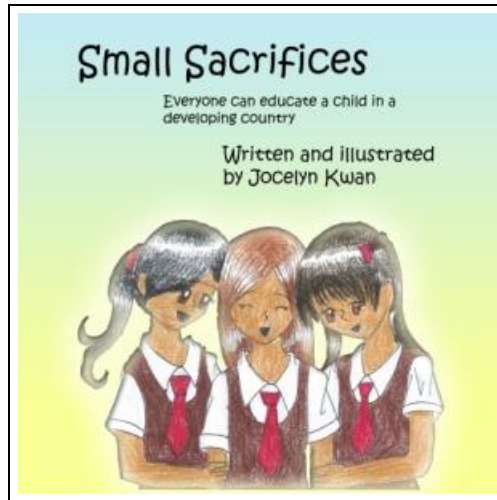

Here is an example: One page explains and illustrates that Giving up 2 movie night tickets can buy a bicycle for a girl in a developing country to ride safely to school. The book covers different world currencies and illustrations are multi-cultural. Illustrations are hand-drawn and hand-coloured with a slight Manga feel. The language is bilingual English and French. (The Amazon information below about the book only allows one language to be specified.) This book will appeal to children, teens, and adults. It is a good resource to promote International-Mindedness and empathy. The message is compelling as readers cannot close the book without realizing that they can make a huge difference by making a small sacrifice of a luxury or fun item and donating the proceeds to charity. There is a page at the end of the book for readers to jot down their ideas of what they will do and turn it into a commitment.
