The opportunity of revisiting the scenes of early days was too tempting to be resisted. My public life had begun in New Zealand, as Civil Commissioner of the Waikato district under the late Sir George Grey, in the interval between the local insignificant Taranaki War of 1860 and the outbreak of the terrible war of races in 1863. The administration of law, such as there was, in the Waikato and all other territory outside the British settlements was at that time carried on by the Maories themselves; the Waikato district was very especially under the jurisdiction of the Maori King and his Runanga.
