




## The Translation of a Savage (Paperback)

In London, he wrote a number of romantic novels, largely concerned with French Canadian history and culture. The Translation of a Savage is a story of cultural differences and mixed marriage. Parker draws upon his knowledge of the Indian tribes of western Canada, telling the tale of an Englishman of family and wealth who marries an Indian girl of Hudson s Bay out of anger at his family. In an attempt to humiliate his relatives, he sends her back to England but remains in Canada, leading to the translation of the title, and...
