Grapholita pallifrontana is a moth species of the family Tortricidae, subfamily Olethreutinae. It is found in most of Europe and the Near East. The wingspan is about 10 mm. The adult moths fly from May until July. The larvae feed within seedpods of Astragalus glycyphyllos. A moth is an insect closely related to the butterfly, both being of the order Lepidoptera. Moths form the majority of this order; there are thought to be 150,000 to 250,000 different species of moth (about ten times the number of species of butterfly), with thousands of species yet to be described.
