However, since 1997, that number has increased more than 6 times resulting in between 1589 to 1895 events per year. Between these time periods, the lethality of terrorist attacks have also increased. Today, the global terrorism threat presents the greatest viable threat to the American people and therefore, is one of the main focuses of the United States...
