




## South East Asian Railway Journeys: Jakarta to Malang (South Java) (Paperback)

Railway travel has the potential to accommodate these requirements. The travelogue style is intended to be anecdotal and illustrative (with photos) and to give the reader an idea of the sort of experiences (good and bad) that one could expect in undertaking the trip.
